




Registration Hierarchy - Levels





Registration Hierarchy - Example



Participant:

- Registers for a scheme including sample requirements
- Defines the receiving address for physical samples

Location:


- Acts as a container for individual instruments
- Is not subscribed to schemes

Instrument:

- Represents an individual physical instrument / meter
- Subscribes to a scheme in order to submit results




Registration Hierarchy - Example




For a physical meter the system will require that you include the Unique serial number when you create the instrument record.

If you enter a serial number that has already been recorder for the specified model, you will be notified at this point.




Where EQA is being performed using a visually read strip or cassette, the 'instrument' should be assigned a unique name as an identifier.




Each instrument you create must be associated with a Location.


For systems which use a different kit for each analyte, and to accommodate open systems, a different analyte selection process is available





The system will mange the unit conversion for you and your report will include the results as you reported them alongside the converted value in standard units utilised in the statistics and performance scores.






